- **Green Spaces:** Projects that create and enhance green spaces and offset carbon. Examples include creating new natural habitats, like ponds and wildflower meadows.
- **Recycling and making the most of resources:** Projects that help to reduce the carbon footprint of community spaces and activities. Examples include recycling and energy saving initiatives.
- **Water saving heroes:** Projects that preserve water and reduce water use. Projects like this will limit the amount of carbon used for water production. Examples include grey water recycling and rainwater harvesting.
